(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

ORDER 2010

Notice is hereby given that on 1st October 2010 the Cambridgeshire County Council has made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and of all other enabling powers the effect of which is to:

- (i) Prohibit any vehicle with more than two wheels using the above byways open to all traffic between 1 October and 30 April, or during any other additional times when any of the gates and posts along the lengths of byway hereinbefore referred to are locked closed.
- (ii) Access will be maintained for pedestrians, equestrians, pedal cycles, horse-drawn vehicles and motor cycles
- (iii) Applications for permits from owners/occupiers of land accessible only from these lengths of road should be made to the undersigned
- (iv) Lockable barriers shall give effect to this Order

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 1 October 2010, a map and a Statement of Reasons for making the Order may be inspected at the office of the undersigned and at the offices of the Chief Executive, East Cambridgeshire District Council, The Grange, Nutholt Lane, Ely during normal office hours.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained within it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, on the ground that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from 14th October 2010 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
